Legislative Leadership Pledge

- WHEREAS the 1st Congress of the United States of America amended the Constitution to protect the right of the people to keep and bear arms; and
- WHEREAS the language of the 2nd Amendment was written in plain English to prevent the government from placing any encroachment, restriction, infringement, or regulation upon the rights of the citizens to keep and bear arms; and
- WHEREAS the Supremacy Clause of Article VI, supplemented by the 10th Amendment, dictates that the 2nd Amendment, as written, is the supreme law of the land; and
- WHEREAS Constitutional Carry is defined as "The legal right for any adult to carry a handgun on their person in public places, either openly or concealed, without the need to first obtain permission or license from, and/or pay a tax, fee, or other monetary obligation, to the State of Texas, or any entity thereof, provided that person can legally possess a firearm under Federal and State law;" and
- WHEREAS an otherwise law-abiding citizen merely exercising his or her right to bear arms, either openly
 or concealed, should not grant law enforcement the authority to detain them; and
- WHEREAS the authority of the State of Texas to require citizens to first obtain an LTC from the State of
 Texas, or a license from another State Government with which Texas has reciprocity, before exercising their
 Constitutionally protected right to bear arms is a de facto tax on, and registration of certain gun owners, and
 is in and of itself an infringement prohibited by the 2nd Amendment; and
- WHEREAS Constitutional Carry of long guns, such as rifles and shotguns, is, and has always been, legal in the State of Texas since the days of the Republic of Texas,
- BE IT RESOLVED that should I, RHONDA SETH, get duly elected to represent HOUSE DISTRICT 25 in the Texas Legislature, I hereby pledge all of the following:
 - ★ I will, to the best of my ability, preserve, protect, and defend the Constitution of the United States of America, including the 2nd Amendment; and
 - X I will, to the best of my ability, provide pro-gun leadership in the Texas Legislature; and
 - X I will introduce or cosponsor, and diligently work towards passage of Constitutional Carry legislation, as defined above; and
 - X I will introduce or cosponsor, and diligently work towards passage of other pro-gun legislation; and
 - X I will diligently work towards requiring a record vote on pro-gun legislation, even if there is significant opposition to it; and
 - X I will adhere to the answers given in the attached questionnaire, and of this pledge, regardless of political pressure I may receive from the Republican Party leadership.
